The June 22nd TVC meeting was held at the Aloha Grange, presided over by TVC President Sally Duyck, and attended by twenty one members. The agenda items included the 2027 meeting schedule, and the 2027 TVC dance schedule. The results from polling the TVC clubs on whether or not to go to quarterly meetings was unanimous yes for those reporting. A motion was made to go to a quarterly schedule beginning after the next TVC meeting. The motion was passed after amending to allow special meetings to be called by the TVC Board. 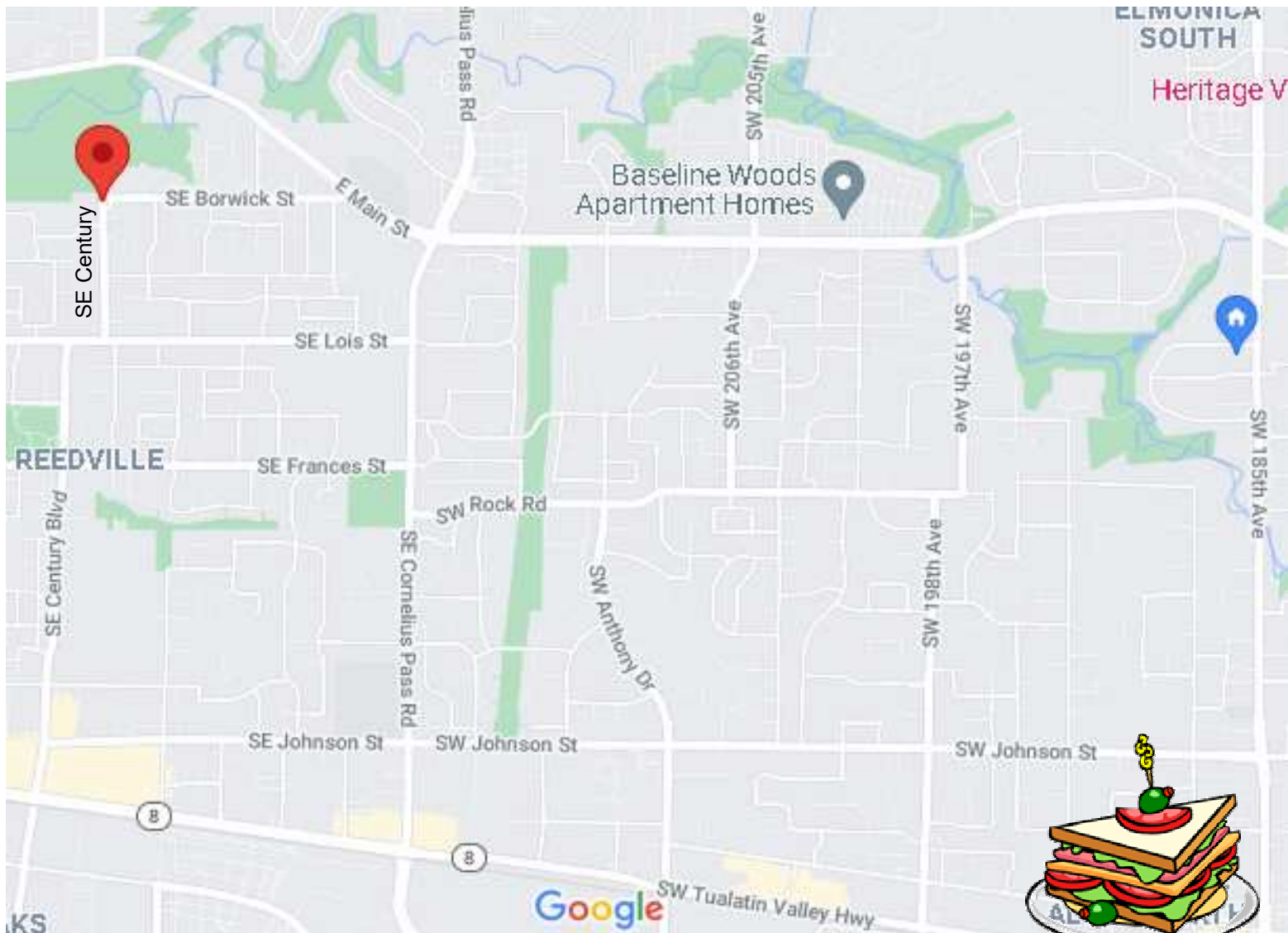
Our picnic is on September 10th at Noble Woods Park.
